JERSEY PREMIUM

If you arrived in Jersey <u>within the last five years</u>, your child could qualify for Jersey Premium Funding.

Jersey Premium helps children to get the best from their education. Your child's school could receive extra funding through Jersey Premium to boost their learning. Schools choose to use Jersey Premium Funding in different ways, depending on what would help children most.

Who is eligible?

- Children from households claiming Income Support;
- Children who live in a 'Registered' household that *could* receive Income Support (i.e. the household meets the requirements of Income Support) but they have lived in Jersey for less than five years;
- Children who are (or have ever been) Looked After Children (i.e. who are under the care of the States of Jersey)

What you need to do

If you have **lived in Jersey for less than five years AND** believe you meet the requirements of Income Support, please answer the questions below. If you need help completing the form, please speak to your child's school. Your answers will help us to establish whether your child is eligible for Jersey Premium funding.
