

Read Write Inc



As a school, d'Auvergne is using Read Write Inc (RWI) as our system of teaching your children to read. It is an inclusive phonics programme, designed to enable all children to learn to read using a synthetic phonics approach.

Children learn the 44 common sounds to the English language and how to blend them to read and spell. It aimed primarily at children from Nursery to Year 2, the aim being that by the end of Year 2, all children will have reached a sufficient reading level at which they can read confidently.

Children will receive between 30 minutes-1 hour of RWI input each day, depending upon the group they are in, and are assessed regularly to ensure they are grouped according to need. This means that children across Reception and Key Stage One are grouped and taught together, depending on attainment.

We are already seeing the impact that RWI is having upon our children, and their confidence in their abilities to read and spell. As a school, we are fully committed to RWI and we believe this the right approach for our children. We are keen to gain as much parental support and involvement as possible.
