House Points

House points can be awarded to students for a variety of reasons. For example:

- Meeting the d’Auvergne Standard in all aspects of school life.
 - Respect for peers and adults around the school.
 - Determination and effort in a piece of work.
 - Earning a d’Auvergne Standard.
 - Outstanding pride in how to wear school uniform.
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- Immaculate behaviour.
- Flawless attendance.
- Academic / sporting achievement.
- Becoming the Star Achiever of the week.

Guidance on Awarding House Points

Throughout the School:

1 House Point (Isolation House Points)	Isolated achievement. E.g. determination and effort in a piece of work, abiding to the class contract etc.
3 House Points (Target House Points)	Achieving a half termly target, becoming a weekly superstar.
5 House Points (Achiever House Points)	Star Achiever (House Points to awarded before Friday lunch collection).
10 House Points (Greater Achievement House Points)	End of term achievements / awards, d'Auvergne Standard.

Maximum 50 isolation House points per week given by class teachers. This excludes achieving targets, star achievers, d'Auvergne Standard etc.

Whole House Competition / Event:

1 st Place	50 House Points
2 nd Place	35 House Points
3 rd Place	20 House Points
4 th Place	10 House Points

House Point Collection / Storage

Collection:

House point marbles are to be distributed by all members of staff. They are to be placed into house display jars in the main corridor by the children who have earned them. This can be during break and lunchtimes. Each marble placed in the jars represents one House point. At the end of every Half Term, House Captains are to count the respective number of marbles for their house and record them on a House point record sheet.

Grosnez	Christmas Jumper Parade	Autumn 2	Children are to wear their best Christmas jumper and take part in an amazing parade in the school hall.
Rozel	d'Auvergne's Got Talent	Spring 1	All children have an opportunity to audition for d'Auvergne's Got Talent. Showcasing the amazing talents we have throughout the school. Platinum, Gold, Silver & Bronze certificates awarded.
Corbiere	Easter Egg Competition	Spring 2	Each child in each year group will have a chance to design their very own Easter Egg at home. First, Second, Third and Fourth in each Year group will be rewarded with House points.
La Rocque	Recycle for La Rocque	Summer 1	House members design and make something out of recycled materials.

Sports Day

d'Auvergne Sports Day is a fantastic opportunity for all members of the school to add to their House point totals.

During Sports Day, each event will have a competitor from each House. At the finish line, competitors will be told the position they have finished in the race. This is then reported to House Point Collectors who are keeping a running total for a specific House. House points earned for the place finished are as follows:

1 st Place – 5 House Points	2 nd Place – 3 House Points	3 rd Place – 2 House Points	4 th Place – 1 House Points
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Lunchtimes

House points can be earned at lunchtimes for excellent behaviour. Children who are a role model at lunchtime have a great chance to boost their House's House point total. Lunchtime staff can distribute House point marbles as they see fit.
