



Ancient Greece

This term, we shall begin with a little bit of geography, by using our mapping skills to find out where Greece is in relation to where we live. We will also think about what makes Greece an appealing place to visit, using our research skills to find out about different aspects of Greek culture.

We'll learn about Zeus, other gods and mythical creatures who live on Mount Olympus and create authentic Ancient Greek pots.

We will use our history skills to explore sources of evidence that tell us about daily life, systems of government, similarities and differences between city states, as well as considering the impact that the ancient Greeks have had on our daily lives.

We will be using our reading skills to explore a range of Greek myths including Midas and the Golden Touch, Pandora's box, Perseus and Medusa and Theseus and the Minotaur. Theseus and the Minotaur will also help us to develop and apply our writing skills as we work towards writing our own myth, complete with hero, villain and special weapons.

Our DT work sees us designing, creating and evaluating our own mini mazes.
