Let's take a MASSIVE step back in time to theSTONE AGE. Turn off your technology, forget the modern world and take a look back on life 5000 years ago.

This term we're going to find a prehistoric site in our local area by studying maps and researching online. We will be spending a day at La Hougue Bie, where we will be immersed in the activities that contributed to the daily lives of the StoneAge people.

Through our research, we'll learn about the Stone Age, the Bronze Age and the Iron Age. What were people's daily lives like and what epic battles did they fight?

Our texts for this term will include Stone Age Boy, which we will use to help us to write our own historical adventure story. We will also be reading How to wash a woolly mammoth as a starting point for writing our own set of instructions.

Using techniques such as cutting, scraping and mark making, we'll make Stone Age tools. We'll look closely at cave paintings and create our own. We will also explore how plants can be used to make natural dyes and create our own examples of weaving.

In science, we will be focusing on living things, looking at what can be planted, grown and eaten as well as Plant life cycles focusing on the function of flowers. We will also consider how animals, including humans move and grow.
