In Reception we set the foundations for early reading by developing children's phonics knowledge, enabling them to decode words and become successful, life-long readers. We will continue to follow the Read Write Inc programme and the children will have lots of opportunities to read a variety of texts. A vocabulary rich environment supports children's reading and understanding of the world and throughout our learning spaces children have access to comfortable reading nooks with lots of opportunities for storytelling.
