This term we will continue to develop our oracy skills of speaking and listening, encouraging all children to find their voice and be effective listeners to their peers and adults. Our show time stage will be a platform for our Reception children to showcase their expressive talents using props, costumes and instruments to explore and engage in music making and dance.

We will be sharing familiar stories like Jack and The Beanstalk, Goldilocks and the Three Bears and the Nativity, learning to retell these stories in a variety of ways whether that be through drama, song or dance.

There will be many opportunities for writing within the provision but also guided writing, where we will be writing and sending letters to the Giant and writing about Goldilocks visiting the Bears' cottage.

In Reception, we like to learn about people, different cultures and communities and as we move towards the end of the calendar year, we'll be exploring why people learn about Remembrance Day and the Hindu festival, Diwali.

Our daily phonic sessions will continue, and the children will become more confident recognising sounds, beginning to blend these sounds together to read and create simple words.

In Maths, our learning will ensure we have a deeper understanding of number and will use questioning to solve mathematical problems. The children will be familiar with the term 'subitise' and will recognise the amount of a group of objects without even counting them. How clever!
