After learning about their cultural significance, we will make beads to go onto our own class dreamcatcher. Looking at aerial views of landmarks, we'll think about how they might have been formed and we will draw them to learn about perspective.

Finally, we'll read and feel inspired by Chief Seattle's famous speech and cook delicious traditional Native American food so that we can share our myths around a campfire.
